

Among the agenda items, the renewal of the Executive Committee and its presidency was deliberated. Our president, Prof. Laurence Ris, will conclude her four-year term and has opted not to seek re-election.

The committee of esteemed individuals designated to seek a new president comprises Jean Schoenen, Laurence Ris, Charles van der Straten Waillet, and Dirk Van Roost.

Brain Awareness Week 2025 will take place from March 10 to March 16.

This year, Ann van der Jeugd has committed to disseminating the call for participation in BAW 2025 among our members. As in previous years, the BBC supports the organization of BAW events in Belgium through a maximum subsidy of €1,000. To qualify for this funding:

Continuing its mission to establish a Belgian Brain Plan and its requisite inclusion in a register of brain disorders, the BBC has commenced the formation of an AISBL, the European Brain₃Data Hub. This strategic decision was made based on the following considerations:





- Knowledge exchange with brain trusts from other Member States
- A unified strategy that enhances initiatives for research and patient support at the European level.
- An initiative designed to facilitate data sharing in compliance with EU regulatory requirements, thereby ensuring the ethical utilization of data.
- Access to diverse databases: By collaborating, researchers and clinicians can obtain a broader and more varied array of data, which is essential for enhancing the understanding of neurological disorders.
- Compliance with the Data Governance
 Act: This initiative aims to facilitate
 structured data sharing in accordance
 with EU regulatory requirements,
 thereby ensuring the ethical utilization
 of data.
- Establishing a data ecosystem: A philanthropic organization facilitates the development of a strong infrastructure for the ethical and transparent collection, analysis, and sharing of data.

- Safeguarding patients' rights: A benevolent data governance framework guarantees the protection of personal information while optimizing its utilization for research purposes.
- Support for collaborative research initiatives: The establishment of an AISBL enhances the ability to submit joint projects for European funding, thereby improving the likelihood of success.
- Accelerating discovery: Interdisciplinary collaboration can expedite innovation in the diagnosis, treatment, and prevention of neurological disorders.
- The establishment of a visibility platform: An association uniting multiple countries enhances the prominence of issues pertaining to brain disorders within the European context.
- Collaborative efforts can more effectively amplify the voices of patients and researchers, thereby mobilizing resources and funding.
- By choosing an altruistic AISBL, boards can establish themselves as leaders in the ethical governance of health data.







